Larry Adams Scholarship in Public Policy

The Larry Adams Scholarship in Public Policy is open to upper division Political Science majors only, who have a strong GPA and will have completed a minimum of 10-12 hours per week in an otherwise unpaid internship in a local government agency during Spring Quarter, 2021. The stipend is \$1,000 with only one award given in selected quarters.
